Club Name: SBCC Stats Club

Club Purpose:

The SBCC Statistics Club aims to provide a welcoming and collaborative environment for students of all skill levels who are studying or interested in statistics. The club will serve as a study group where beginners can enhance their understanding of statistics with the support of more experienced peers, and advanced students can offer guidance and tutoring. We will also engage in discussions, projects, and activities related to real-world statistical applications to enhance practical learning.

Objectives:

1. Foster an inclusive study environment for students enrolled in statistics courses.
2. Offer tutoring and peer-to-peer support to enhance statistical understanding.
3. Host weekly or bi-weekly meetings to discuss concepts, homework, and statistical tools.
4. Organize workshops or guest lectures on applied statistics in different fields (business, science, social research, etc.).
5. Promote collaboration on projects and case studies that demonstrate practical applications of statistics.

Meeting Frequency:

The club will meet once or twice a week depending on student schedules and needs. The meeting place will be determined after the club's charter has been approved.

Target Membership:

Open to all SBCC students, including beginners looking to learn statistics and advanced students interested in helping others.

Statistics Club Constitution

Article I – SBCC STATS CLUB

The name of this organization shall be the SBCC Statistics Club.

Article II – Purpose

The purpose of the Statistics Club is to:

- Create a welcoming and inclusive environment for students interested in statistics.
- Support students enrolled in statistics courses through peer tutoring and collaborative study.
- Provide opportunities for advanced students to mentor and assist beginners.
- Facilitate workshops, discussions, and projects on statistical applications in various fields.

Article III – Authority

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV – Membership

1. Membership is open to all SBCC students interested in statistics, regardless of skill level.
2. Members are encouraged to contribute to the club's activities and attend meetings regularly.

Article V – Officers

1. **President:**
 - Presides over meetings.
 - Represents the club in dealings with the Associated Student Government and other campus organizations.
2. **Vice President:**
 - Assists the President and assumes duties in the President's absence.
3. **Secretary:**
 - Keeps records of meetings, attendance, and club activities.
 - Manages club communication and meeting schedules.
4. **Treasurer:**

- Manages the club's finances and oversees fundraising efforts.

Article VI – Elections

Officers shall serve one term(s) and will be elected each beginning of the semester.

Article VII – Meetings

1. Regular meetings will be held weekly or bi-weekly, depending on the availability of members.
2. The meeting place will be determined once the club is chartered, and all members will be informed in advance.

Article VIII – Amendments
