Article I

(Name of Club)

The name of this club will be Web Development Club

Article II

(Purpose of Club)

The Club has been organized to provide a collaborative space for students interested in web development to enhance their skills through projects and workshops. Support members in developing full-stack web development skills, covering frontend and backend technologies. Encourage the development of professional portfolios by completing major web development projects each semester.

Article III

(Authority)

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV

(Membership) (Mandatory)

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V

(Meetings)

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

Article VI

(Officers)

- President – Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings. Manages projects.
- Vice President – Support presidents, takes over in his/her absence.
- Operations Coordinator– Records minutes of club meetings. Keeps financial records.
- Lead Front-End Developer – Provides guidance and mentorship to club members on front-end technologies
- Lead Back-End Developer - Provides guidance on back-end development technologies and manages server-side project components.

Article VII

(Elections)

Officers shall serve 1 term(s) and will be elected each semester.

Article VIII

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 60% of the Club members.
